AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF MARVIN, NORTH CAROLINA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 93 §93.65, REVISION OF TREE PLANTING MITIGATION REQUIREMENTS IN THE VILLAGE OF MARVIN, NORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, ordinance §93.65 (A) (entitled “Tree Planting Mitigation”, specifically regarding the column “Replacement Canopy Trees”) has been assessed by the Union County Urban Forester to be a difficult requirement for developers and smaller trees have a higher chance of survival; and

WHEREAS, he has also assessed that it is erroneous to measure new trees using dbh instead of caliper;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council for the Village of Marvin, North Carolina that:

Section 1. Title IX: GENERAL REGULATIONS, Chapter 93.65 (A) entitled “Tree Planting Mitigation”, of the Code of Ordinance of the Village of Marvin, North Carolina shall be rewritten and amended as follows:

§ 93.65 TREE PLANTING MITIGATION.

(A) Where removal of existing trees is approved as part of an approved site plan, subdivision plat or tree removal permit, new trees shall be planted in the general vicinity of the trees removed, in accordance with the following schedule:

<i>Tree Removed</i>	<i>Replacement Canopy Tree</i>	<i>Replacement Understory Tree</i>
3 inch caliper to less than 18 inches dbh tree	One 3 inch caliper tree	One 2 inch caliper tree
18 - 24 inch dbh tree	Two 4 inch caliper trees or one 6 inch caliper tree	
24 inch+ dbh tree	Two 6 inch caliper trees or one 8 inch caliper tree	

This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption and ordered published as provided by law. Adopted and effective this day of 14th of January 2020.
