**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF MARVIN CHARTER
CHANGING THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR MAYOR FROM TWO YEARS TO FOUR YEARS**


BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council for the Village of Marvin that:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to NCGS 160A-101 and 160A-102, the Charter of the Village of Marvin, as set forth in Chapter 879 of the 1969 Session Laws of North Carolina, as amended, is hereby further amended in Chapter III, Sec. 3-4, to provide that the mayor shall hereafter be elected by all the qualified voters of the Village for a term of four (4) years.

SECTION 2. The Village Clerk shall cause a notice to be duly published, stating that an ordinance amending the Charter to provide for election of the Mayor by all the qualified voters of the Village of Marvin for a four-year term has been adopted. Subject to any referendum petitioned for and conducted pursuant to NCGS 160A-103, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after September 11, 2016.


SECTION 3. The first such four (4) year term shall be served by the Mayor elected in the 2017 Mayoral election.
