3. Discussion of specific functionality or elements seen on other websites

The committee highlighted features they thought useful from other municipal sites, including City of Concord's residents' tab, the Town of Stallings' method for posting meeting agendas and minutes, as well as other functionalities used on the websites for the Town of Matthews, the Town of Cornelius, and the Town of Waxhaw.
